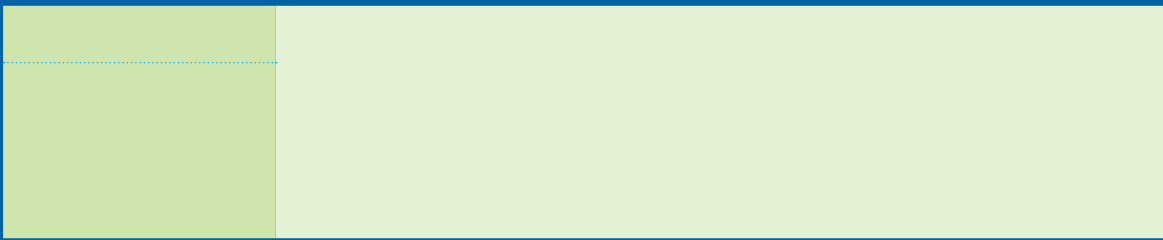
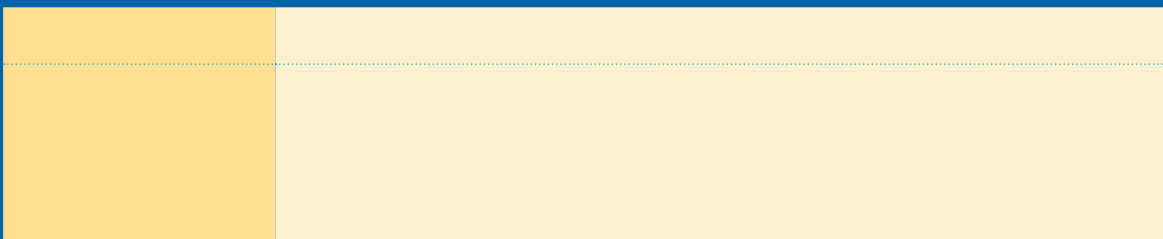


The General Achievement Test (GAT) assesses a range of skills, measures literacy and numeracy standards and supports quality assurance processes.
